Each Recycled Phone Funds 30 Minutes of Free Long-Distance Service for Military Personnel; Helps Keep 'The Emerald City' Green

According to the U.S. EPA, only 13% of the 2 billion cell phones sold each year are recycled, with the remaining 87% going to landfills or incinerators. In partnership with MetroPCS and Cell Phones For Soldiers, Kyocera is asking you to recycle your old/unwanted cell phones between now and August 31 at one of 16 MetroPCS retail locations in the greater Seattle area.
